Bottled from beneath certified organic land, Life is carbon neutral at source and the materials from lid to label are 100% recyclable.

The eco-bottle is the lightest weight PET bottle on the market so our customers are significantly reducing their plastic waste.

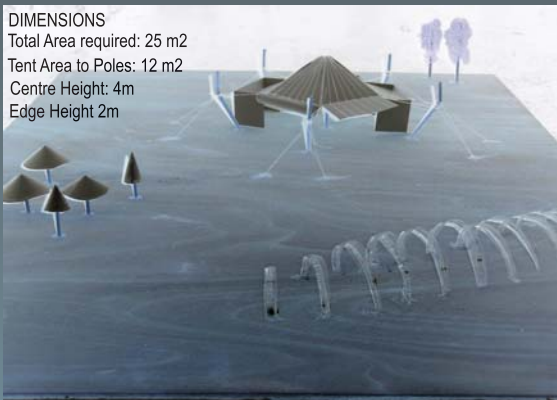
Our partners, the award-winning Circus Kinetica will be working to create a bespoke piece of public art for each festival using Life water bottles.

The tent will also serve as a hub where festival-goers can bring their bottles and cans for recycling. It follows our joint ethos of sustainability utilising alternative power sources and even collecting rain, providing water for the camp.
